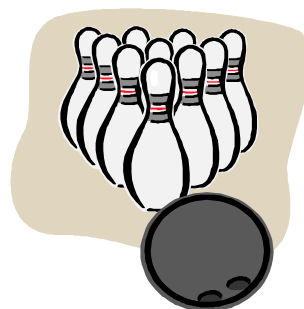
Note from Jackie:
