## Buffalo Chicken Dip

### INGREDIENTS:

(2)8 oz. pkg. cream cheese, softened  
½ cup blue cheese dressing  
½ cup ranch salad dressing  
½ to 1 cup FRANK'S REDHOT Sauce

## MORONS

Town of Onondaga, NY – A Parish man who was participating in a motorcycle helmet protest ride was killed this afternoon when he went over the handlebars of his motorcycle and injured his head on the pavement, state police said. Philip A. Contos, 55, of 45 East St., Parish, was not wearing a helmet while driving a 1983 Harley Davidson motorcycle south on Route 11 in Onondaga with a large group of other motorcyclists, troopers said. About 1:30 p.m., troopers said, Contos hit his brakes, the motorcycle fishtailed and went out of control and Contos went over the handlebars. Contos was taken to Upstate University Hospital where he was pronounced dead, troopers said. Evidence at the scene and information from the attending physician indicate Contos would have survived if he had been wearing a Department of Transportation approved helmet, troopers said. The protest in which Contos was riding was organized by American Bikers Aimed Towards Education, Trooper Jack Keller said.
